To survey and monument the tracts of land shown PURPOSE:

This survey is basically a retracement of Jackson PROCEDURE:

County Recorded No. 1986. An extensive search was conducted for the monuments established by Recorded Survey No. 1986. Several of these monuments were found as indicated on the attached map of survey. All of the found monuments compared quite favorably to the record with the exception of the location of the centerline of Ridge Way. When Recorded Survey No. 1986 was conducted in June of 1962 by Leland P. Lovejoy, R.L.S., Ridge Way was unimproved. Surveyor Lovejoy apparently used the centerline of Ridge Way as it existed in 1962 which conformed closely with the record location of the North line of Lot 41, Fairview Addition to the City of Medford. In March of 1967, Recorded Survey No. 3388 was conducted by Edward A. McGinty, R.L.S. As a result of Recorded Survey No. 3388, Surveyor McGinty proportionally located the centerlines of several streets, one of which was Ridge Way. This proportional location fell more or less 3 feet North of the existing apparent centerline of Ridge Way. The proportional location of Ridge Way has been excepted by the city and the present existing improved Ridge Way conforms to the Recorded Survey No. 3388 location. Research of property deeds in this area revealed the majority of them were based on measurements and property corners set forth by Recorded Survey No. 1986. It was therefore decided that the monuments of Recorded Survey No. 1986 would hold with the exception of those along the Southerly right of way line of Ridge Way. All monuments set along said Southerly line in the course of this survey, conform to the existing improved centerline of Ridge Way.
