SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

Boyden, a duly registered surveyor of the State of Oregon, being first duly sworn, do hereby certify that under my direction, the tract of land hereon shown has been correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments, and the said plat is a correct representation of the same, and the following is an accurate description of the boundary lines:
