

Using the four 1/4 coners I established the Center 1/4 as shown on the Plat.

At the Center 1/4 of Section 4 I set a 5/8" Iron Rod and scribed

A B. Oak 12 ins. diam., West, 26.16 feet.

A Y. Pine 18 ins. diam., North 34 West, 10.84 feet.

A Y. Pine 12 ins. diam., North 34 East, 14.84 feet.

A D. Fir 10 ins. diam., South 30 East, 22.88 feet.

with 3/4" Iron Pipe per survey 121 being South 32.19 feet and West, 6.23 feet. (see Plat)

At the Centerwest 1/16 corner of Section 4 I set a 5/8" Iron Rod and scribed

A Y.Pine 24 ins. diam., North 67°West, 38.67 feet. A Y.Pine 14 ins. diam., South 72°East, 30.55 feet. (previously scribed) with a 3/4" Iron Pipe per survey no. 121 being East 38.09 feet and South 14.63 feet (see Plat).

I also subdivided the Southwest 1/4 of Section 4, the corners I found are the West 1/16 corner common to Section 4 and 9 I found a 1" Iron Pipe and B.T.'s per survey no. 121, the corner is South 3.68 feet and East 0.32 feet.

At the Southwest Section corner common to Section 4,5,8,9, I found a 3/8" x $1\frac{1}{2}"$ Iron Bar and B.T. per survey no. 121

A Y. Pine 30 ins. diam., North 63° East, 34.7 feet

At the South 1/16 corner common to Section 4 and 5 I found a 3/4" Iron Pipe and B.T's per survey no. 3766.

I then surveyed the property as shown on the Plat.

Meridian is based on the West line of the Northwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 4, per survey no. 4929.

PURPOSE:

To survey a parcel of land situated in the Southwest 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 4, Township 35 South, Range 4 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PROCEDURE:

Beginning at the West 1/4 corner common to Sections 4 and 5, at which I found a 3/4" Iron Pipe and B.T's per survey no. 121,

A Y. Pine 20 ins. diam., North $32\frac{10}{8}$ East, 39.0 feet. A Y. Pine 18 ins. diam., South $34\frac{10}{8}$ West, 14.8 feet.

Thence I surveyed to the Centerwest 1/16 corner of Section 4, per survey no. 121, at which I found a 1" Iron Pipe and one B.T.

A Y. Pine 14 ins. diam., North 61048' West, 9.60 feet.

The record distance and measured distance did not match by a large amount, (see Plat) also shown on Survey no. 4915, I surveyed to the Center 1/4 of Section 1/4 of Section 4, at which I found a 1" Iron Pipe and B.T.'s, per survey no. 121.

A B. Oak 20 ins. diam., North 89° East, 35 feet. (the second B.T. is gone)

This corner did not match record (see Plat) therefore I subdivided the Section.

At the East 1/4 corner common to Section 3 and 4, I found a County Surveyor's Brass Cap and B.T.'s.

At the North 1/4 corner common to Section 4 and 33, I found a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " Iron Pipe and B.T.'s.

At the South 1/4 corner common to Section 4 and 9, I found a 3/4" Iron Pipe and B.T.'s.
