On March 11, 1978, it was discovered that the monument (and original stone) established to mark the position of the northwest corner donation land claim number 67, also 'L' corner donation land claim number 43, had been removed by pipeline construction work at the Medford Forest Nursery.

It is not known if iron pins set to reference this corner have been disturbed. However, considerable construction activity has occurred in this immediate area.

At the position of the found stone I set a 2 1/2" x 30" galvanized iron post 36" below ground surface, with a 2 1/2" diameter bronze cap marked:

I placed the found stone upright and to north of monument with 'X' at 0.75 feet distance from iron pipe and pour concrete around both to stabilize monuments.

A 5/8 inch diameter 24 inch long iron pin bears N45°E, 50.0 feet distance set 30" below ground surface.

A 5/8 inch diameter 24 inch long iron pin bears S45°E 50.0 feet distance set 30" below ground surface.

A 5/8 inch diameter 24 inch long iron pin bears S45°W, 50.0 feet distance set 30" below ground surface.

A 5/8 inch diameter 24 inch long iron pin bears N45°W, 50.0 feet distance set 30" below ground surface.

A 2 1/2 inch \times 30 inch galvanized iron post set flush with ground, with a 2 1/2 inch bronze cap bears N00° 01' 54"E, 783.521 feet distance (see accompanying map).

A 1 1/2 inch diameter x ? long iron pipe bears S00° 01' 54"W 327.928 feet distance (this pipe locally accepted monument for South-Southeast Donation Land Claim Corner No. 43).

I incorporated the above described monuments into the triangulation pattern shown on the accompanying map.

PROCEDURE:

From evidence found and verified by subsequent survey, the corners shown on the attached map were incorporated into related boundary surveys, verified, and finally

referenced as shown.

CORNERS REFERENCED THIS SURVEY: East Southeast Donation Land Claim Corner No. 43.

I found a l inch, inside diameter, galvanized iron pipe set as reference for corner. No other evidence found as described in November 21, 1951, Jackson County Surveyor Reestablishment Records.

I accepted this monument after verification with monuments found along perimeter of adjoining tracts. As the position of said D.L.C. corner falls on a now existing concrete pipe being part of a larger concrete structure in a large irrigation ditch, (both the ditch and irrigation structure are planned for removal during the summer of 1977.) I set no monument at the corner position.

I reference the accepted corner position as follows:

A 5/8" diameter 24" long iron pin bears N45°E 50.0 feet distance set 30" below ground surface.

A 5/8" diameter 24" long iron pin bears S45°E 50.0 feet distance set 30" below ground surface.

A 1" inside diameter 36" long galvanized iron pipe bears S45°W 50.0 feet distance set 30" below ground surface.

A 1" inside diameter 36" long galvanized iron pipe bears N45°W 50.0 feet distance set 36" below ground surface.

Reestablished Northwest Corner Donation Land Claim No. 67 also Interior East Southeast Corner Donation Land Claim No. 43.

Found 5" x 9" x 20" pyramid shaped basalt stone with 'X' on top.

A 5/8" x ?" iron pin 6" below ground surface bears N88° 31'E 100.02 feet distance record S89° 45'E 100.00 feet distance (top 5" of pin bent to north).

Evidence of old fence post to northwest and below stone. No other evidence as described in November 8, 1939, Jackson County Reestablishment found.
