PURPOSE:

To survey and monument the subject tract shown

SURVEY EQUIPMENT: Wild TlA and 200 foot steel tape

PROCEDURE: Recorded Survey No. 4336 located and established the centerlines of Wightman, Iowa, and California Streets and also monumented the Northeast corner of the subject tract to be surveyed. Field ties to existing monuments were made and checked with original field work done by Verlyn Thomas, Professional Land Surveyor, in November 1969. To keep in harmony with said original monumentation, this surveyor rotated all deed calls of "North" to North 00° 03' 05" West so as to be parallel with Wightman Street. An existing fence line located on the East boundary of the subject tract was located and perpetuated on the attached map.
