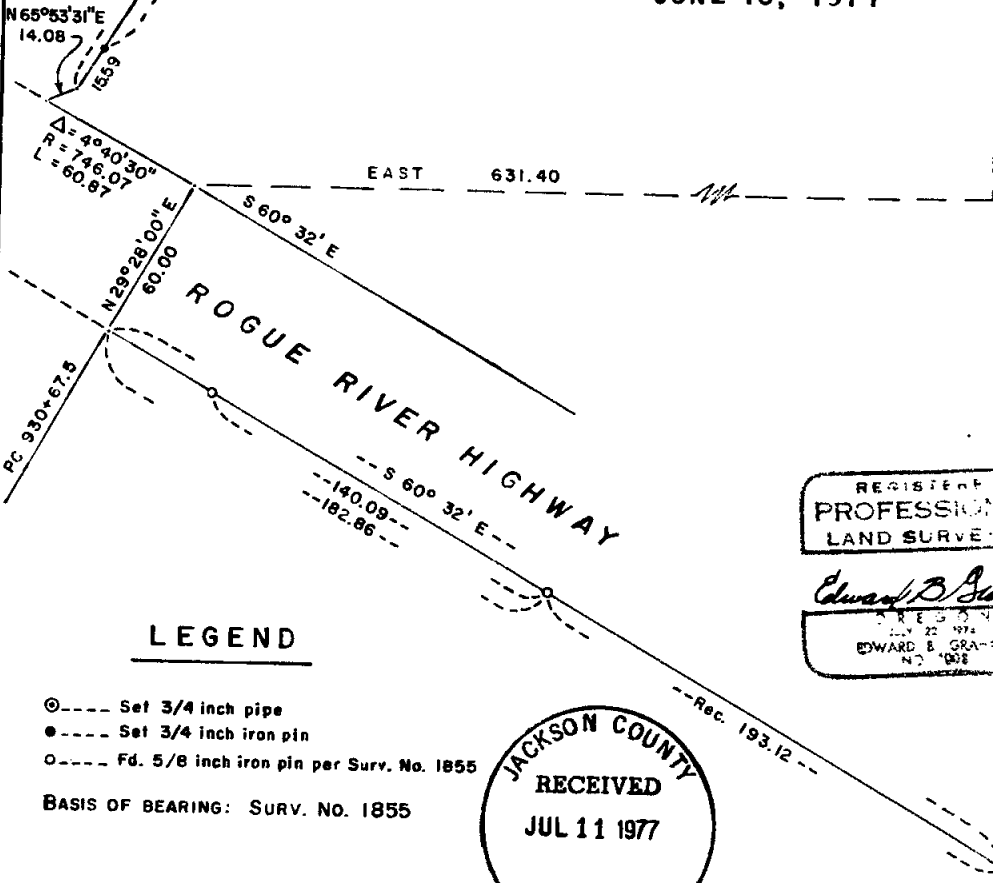

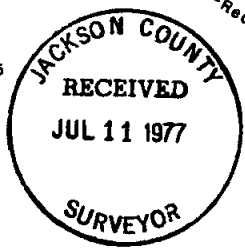

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 O.R.S.

SURVEY FOR: Jackson County Parks Department.

LOCATION: Northeast 1/4 of Section 21, Township 36 South, Range 4 West, W.M., Jackson County, Oregon and known as Fleming Add. to Rogue River.

BY: Jackson County Surveyors Office.

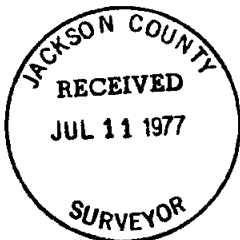
DATE: June 10, 1977.

PURPOSE: To locate and describe a boundary line agreed upon by the County Parks Dept. and the adjoiner to the West.

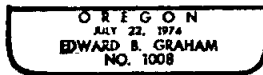
BASIS OF BEARING: Survey No. 1855 along Rogue River Highway. Curve data from 1922 as built highway map.

PROCEDURE: The monuments shown on the accompanying map fixing the boundary line were placed by the parties involved. The monuments were then tied by traverse to the improvements, the highway line and subsequently the corner common to Sections 15, 16, 21 and 22, Township 36 South, Range 4 West.
