## SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

SURVEY FOR:

LOCATION:

Northwest one-quarter (1/4) of Section 31, Township 33 South, Range 1 East, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon


PURPOSE:

To make a dependent resurvey of Recorded Survey No. 1807 and 5278 in order to verify that our client's Westerly property line had been properly monumented in the field as per his property description and as shown on Recorded Survey No. 5278. A review of our client's legal description and Recorded Survey No. 1807 and 5278 found all to be in order with only a small discrepancy in said Westerly line of the subject tract (Recorded Survey No. 5278 = North 34° 39' 41" West 163.44 feet; computed record = North 34° 39' 28" West 163.42 feet). The distance of 981.60 feet of Thomas H. Cody, Jr. survey (Recorded Survey No. 5278) from the Northwest corner of Section 31, Easterly along the North section line thereof to intersect the centerline of Elk Creek Road agreed favorably with the computed distance of 981.48 feet acquired from this office's files of Leland P. Lovejoy (Recorded Survey No. 1807). All this information and research was supplied to our client prior to his request for this resurvey.

PROCEDURE: Ran a random traverse Easterly from the Northwest corner of Section 31 to the North one-quarter (1/4) corner of said Section 31, tying in existing monuments as shown on attached map. The distance of 981.60 feet to the centerline of Elk Creek Road was checked and used. Set monuments at the Northwest corner and Northeast corner of the subject tract as shown. A 5/8 inch iron pin was found South 88° 27' 35" East 20.06 feet from the record position of the Northwest corner of the subject tract.
