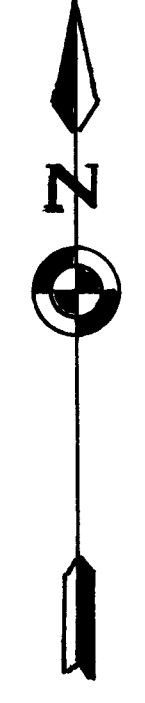

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

FOR: Ray Mitchell  
8000 Dead Indian Hwy.  
Ashland, Oregon

PURPOSE: To monument and describe the tracts as shown on the accompanying map and to locate an existing private road for easement purposes.

PROCEDURE: The location of all new boundaries established by this survey were positioned according to the clients instructions. The record Westerly and Southerly boundaries were not established by this survey, but were protracted as shown on the accompanying map. The position of the Easterly boundary of recorded survey no. 5352 was recalculated using recorded survey no. 6654. As no County Road monuments were available for Cove Road, the existing mean centerline of the main travelled way was used as control. The client is well aware of the statutory regulations governing subdivision and partitions, and after discussing this matter with the County Planning staff, he was instructed that in creating the road easement to serve the parcel created by recorded survey no. 5352, he did not need the approval of the Planning Commission, as this record survey predates the regulations governing the same.
