PURPOSE:

To describe Scenic Avenue right of way between the 1910 survey line laying out and extablishing the County Road, Scenic Avenue, and the property located to the South along Griffin Creek known

as Green Glen Subdivision, Unit #1.

Recorded Survey No. 3439 was used to establish PROCEDURE: the basis of bearings and to re-establish the 1910 survey line laying out and establishing Scenic Avenue between Grant Road, a County Road, and Dobrot Way, a City Street. P.K. nails with discs were found in Scenic Avenue-Grant Road intersection West of the Jackson Creek concrete box culvert and North of a 5/8 inch iron pin found on the Northeast corner of the parcel surveyed in Recorded Survey No. 3439. The point designated as Station 368+05.6 (1910 Road Notes) shown in Recorded Survey No. 3439 was re-established. Thence, the said point was occupied as the point of beginning of the herein survey. Proceeding North 89° 46' West 43.14 feet, thence South 00° 14' 00" East 37.12 feet to the Initial Point of Green Glen Subdivision, Unit #1, thence North 89° 58' 00" West along the South line of Scenic Avenue which is the North line of Green Glen Subdivision, Unit #1, to a found 5/8 inch iron pipe, thence North 00° 14' 00" West 38.18 feet where a 5/8 inch iron pin was set on the 1910 survey line, thence South 89° 46' East along the 1910 survey line 348.74 feet to the point of beginning described as Station 368+05.6 in the 1910 survey as indicated in the petition for road PROFESSIONAL
