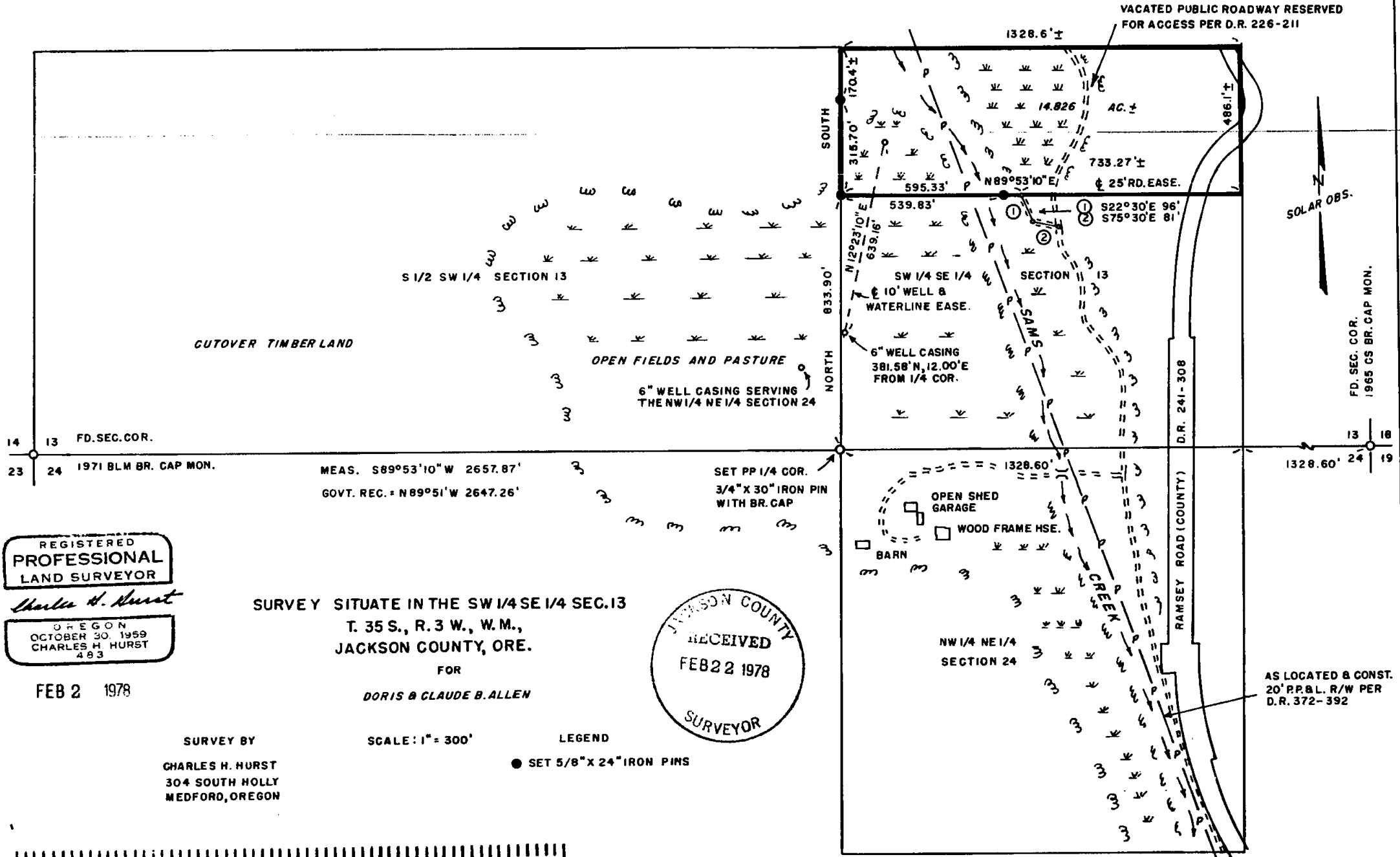

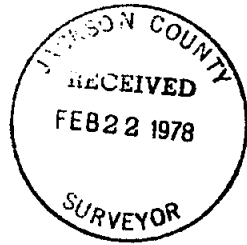

Purpose : To separate the tract shown

Procedure

No evidence of the quarter corner common to Sections 13 and 24 being found, said corner was set on the basis of single proportionate remeasurement.

Witness corners were set on the west and south lines of the tract shown inasmuch as it was not economically feasible for the client to subdivide Section 13 in order to determine the north and East line of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  at this time.

The west line of said tract is not intended to coincide with any sub-divisional line of Section 13.

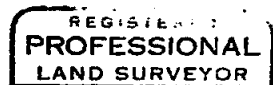
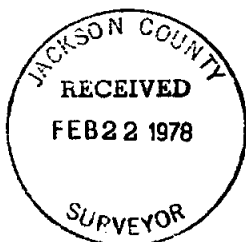
The proportionate quarter corner common to Sections 13 and 24 is designated by a  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 30" iron pin with brass cap mkd.

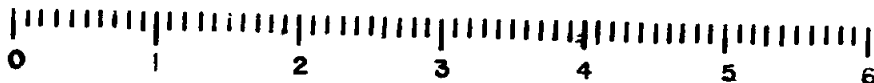
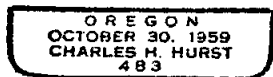
