

TIES WERE MADE TO PINS SET BY THE COUNTY ROAD DEPARTMENT ON THE WESTERLY RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF HUMBUG CREEK ROAD. SAID PINS VARY BY APPROXIMATELY ONE-HALF (1/2) FOOT FROM THE INTENDED LOCATION SHOWN ON SURVEY NO. 5209. COUNTY ROAD DATA AS SHOWN ON SAID SURVEY WAS HELD AND NO ATTEMPT WAS MADE TO ADJUST SAID COUNTY PINS TO THEIR CORRECT LOCATION IN THE FIELD.

NO ATTEMPT WAS MADE TO TRAVERSE HUMBUG CREEK TO DETERMINE EXACT ACREAGES.

A PORTION OF THE SOUTHEAST ONE-QUARTER (1/4) OF THE SOUTHWEST ONE-QUARTER (1/4) OF SECTION 14, TOWNSHIP 38 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN,

JACKSON COUNTY, OREGON.

PURPOSE:

TO CREATE AND MONUMENT THREE PARCELS

AS SHOWN ON THE ATTACHED MAP.

PROCEDURE:

THE MAJOR PORTION OF THE LANDS LYING WITHIN THE BOUNDARYS OF THESE THREE PARCELS WAS ACQUIRED BY THE PITTOCK'S BY INSTRUMENT NO. 78-01791, JACKSON COUNTY OFFICIAL RECORDS. HOWEVER, THE DESCRIPTION STARTS AT A POINT WHERE THE NORTH LINE OF THE SOUTH ONE-HALF (1/2) OF THE SOUTH ONE-HALF (1/2) OF SECTION 14 INTERSECTS THE WEST LINE OF HUMBUG CREEK ROAD. SINCE MANY OF THE HUMBUG CREEK ROAD. ORIGINAL SECTION CORNERS HAVE NEVER BEEN RE-ESTABLISHED, IT WOULD HAVE BEEN QUITE EXPENSIVE TO ESTABLISH THE NORTH BOUNDARY OF THIS PARCEL. I HAVE THERE-FORE PREPARED A CORRECTION DEED FOR MR. PITTOCK WHICH, IN ESSENCE, DESCRIBES APPROXIMATELY THE SAME PIECE OF PROPERTY, EXCEPT IT TIES TO THE SOUTH LINE OF SECTION 14 AS SHOWN ON THE ATTACHED MAP.

THE PITTOCK'S OWNED THE LAND NORTH OF THE PARCEL DESCRIBED IN INSTRUMENT NO. 78-01791. SINCE THE PLANNING DEPARTMENT REQUIRED EACH PARCEL TO BE A MINIMUM OF 300 FEET WIDE, THE NORTHERLY PARCEL SHOWN ON THE ATTACHED MAP OVERLAPS ON MR. PITTOCK'S PREVIOUSLY OWNED PARCEL.
