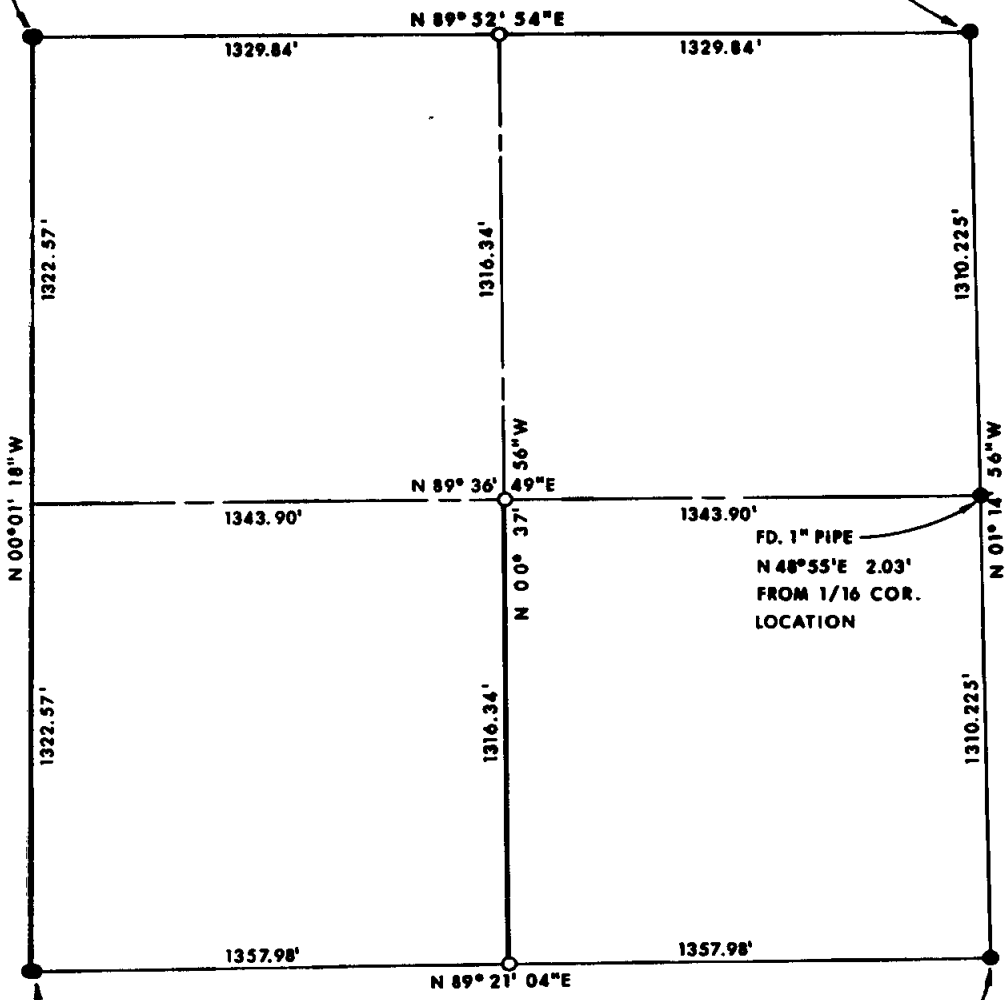

FD. 1" CAPPED PIPE WITH B.T.S MARKING THE CTR. SEC. 24

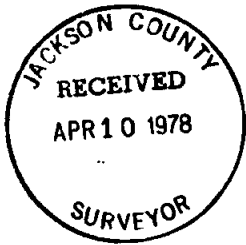
FD. 1-1/2" PIPE WITH B.T.S MARKING THE EAST 1/4 SEC. 24

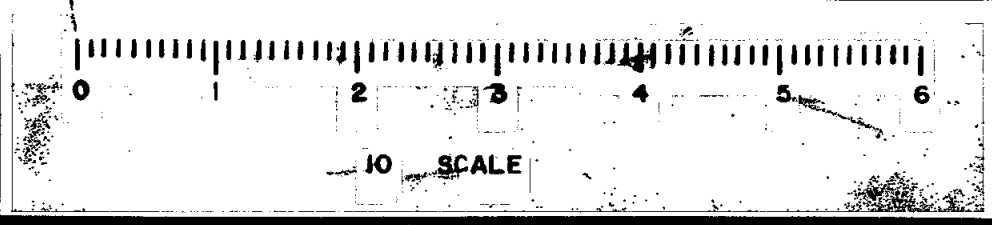

PROCEDURE: USING THE CONTROL I ESTABLISHED ON
SURVEY NO. 6521, I TIED TO THE CENTER
ONE-QUARTER (1/4) CORNER OF SAID
SECTION 24. WITH THIS INFORMATION AND
THE DATA SHOWN ON SURVEY NO. 6521, I
FRACTIONIZED THE SOUTHEAST ONE-QUARTER
(1/4) OF SECTION 24 AND SET THE CORNERS
AS SHOWN ON THE ATTACHED MAP.

A SEARCH WAS MADE FOR THE CENTER EAST
ONE-SIXTEENTH (1/16) CORNER OF SECTION
24. THIS CORNER FALLS IN A CREEK
BOTTOM AND APPARENTLY HAS BEEN DESTROYED.
