## APPROXIMATION BOUNDARY

The purpose of filing this as a survey is that in the event — at some future date to make sure that no one will construe this as a boundary survey and in no way is there any express or written warranty as to its accuracy.

The client is aware of this, also he requested that I not file it as a survey inasmuch as he did not want the additional expense of traverse and closure.

The only purpose of setting monuments is to

1. Perpetuate work done

 Utilization of this survey in the event, at a future date, the client may need a boundary survey.

Approx. 4 years ago I made an open end traverse along the East line of the Northeast one quarter for confirmation of the East one quarter corner. Most old traverse points were recovered, although a few were in bad shape. Computed offsets, set lath on line dependent on the accuracy of hubs found and previous traverse.

Thence ran westerly from a computed position, as shown.
