Purpose:

To monument the tract of land as shown on the accompanying map and as described in instrument number 0.R. 77 - 21111 of Jackson County official records.

Procedure:

A closed traverse, using electronic measuring equipment and a T2 Theodolite was made, encompassing found monuments from previous surveys and the NW and SW corners of DLC no. 60.

It was interesting to find that all of the surveys previously done in the area purported to tie to the west line of DLC No. 60. However, I could not find the relationahip of the bolt in Berrydale Avenue or the 5/8 inch pin set on survey number 2154 to be as represented.

Survey number 4669 contains in it a copy of an old subdivision done by J.S. Howard for S.L. Bennett. A search of the deed records and a retracement of the conveyances made by S.L. Bennett follow the dimensions on the old subdivision map. Mr. Bennett owned to the west line of DLC no. 60. Therefore, it is certain that the bearing "South" in the first course from the NW corner of DLC no. 60 in the descriptions was intended to follow the West line of the DLC.

The retracement of the conveyances indicates that the tract owned by Mr. Adams has substantial senior rights.
