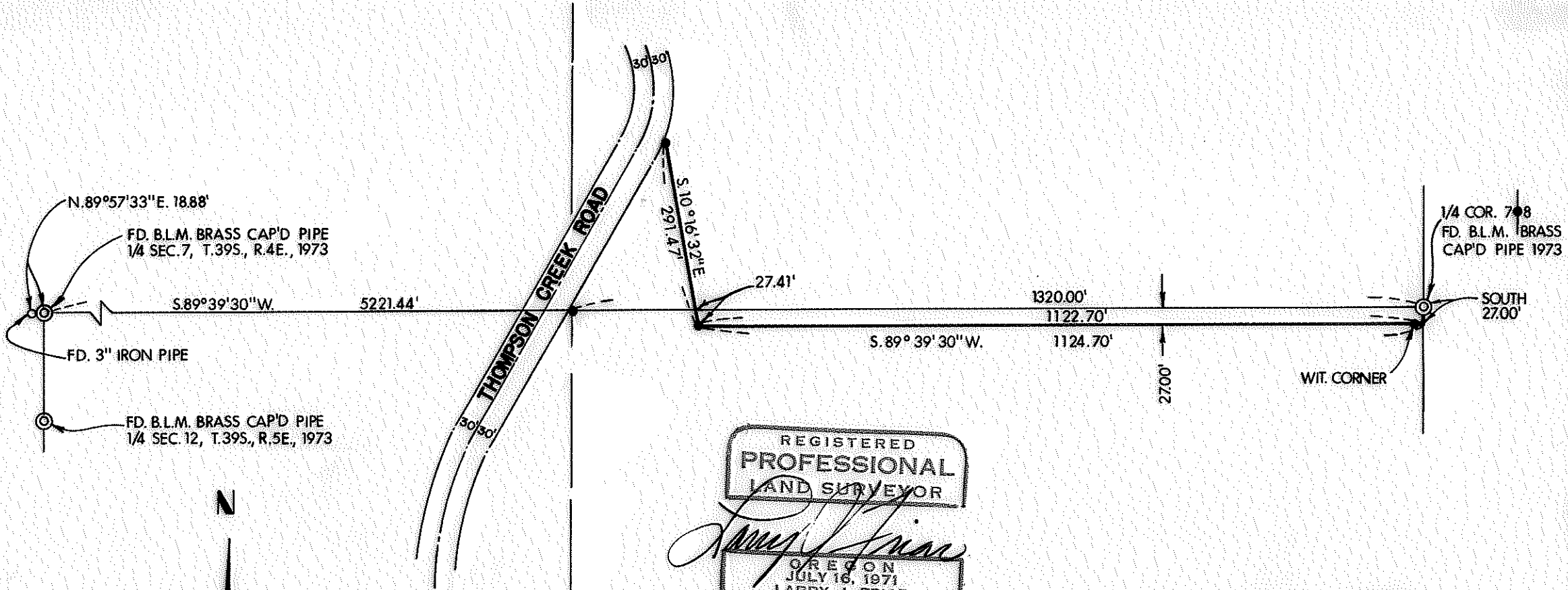

LOCATION: SOUTHEAST ONE-QUARTER (1/4) SECTION 7,  
TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, WILLA-  
METTE MERIDIAN, JACKSON COUNTY, OREGON.

PURPOSE: TO MONUMENT A LINE BETWEEN ADJACENT  
LAND OWNERS PROVIDING ACCESS TO THE  
PARCEL ON THE SOUTH AND A STRIP OF  
APPROXIMATELY EQUAL AREA TO BE DEEDED  
IN EXCHANGE.

PROCEDURE: MADE A RANDOM TRAVERSE USING E.D.M.  
EQUIPMENT, FROM THE WEST QUARTER CORNER  
TO THE EAST QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION  
7. THEN LOCATED AND MONUMENTED LINES  
AS SHOWN ON THE ATTACHED MAP.

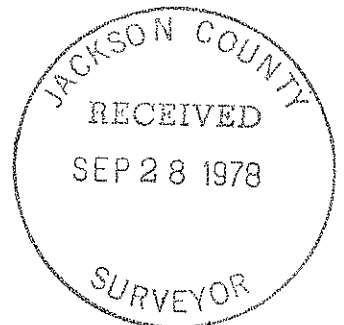
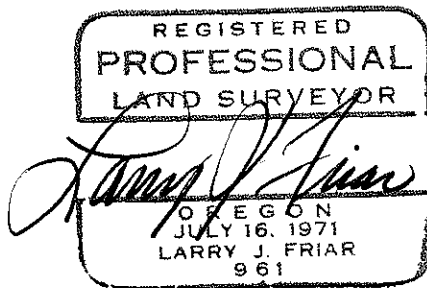
THE MONUMENT SET ON THE EAST WEST CENTER-  
LINE OF SECTION NEAR THE EASTERLY LINE  
OF THOMPSON CREEK ROAD IS A POINT ON  
LINE ONLY AND IS NOT A ONE-SIXTEENTH  
CORNER.

THE RIGHT-OF-WAY SHOWN ON THOMPSON  
CREEK ROAD IS APPROXIMATE.
