Precedence of Survey:

This is a partial retracement of Survey No.s 1125 and 3742. Tracts abutting the county road were conveyed from benefit of Survey of Record No. 1125. Survey No. 3742 was a partial retracement of Survey No. 1125 for the purpose of maintaining the original boundaries and the intent of Deed, with the exception of Survey No. 3742,

Tracts 1, 2, 3 & 4 are shown as proposed segregations.

Monuments:

A. Being a 5/8 in. from pin approx. 5.5 ft. deep, now a steel fence 6 ft. long

B. Found 3/4 in. iron pipe. 6 ins. deer

C. D. & E. 5/8 in. iron pins found.

Monuments set being 5/8 in. x 24 in. iron pins.

Portions of previous suffey No. 3742 were utilized to locate private road for a proposed Major Partition, size of tracts subject to change.
