
The precedence of survey and the accuracy of this survey is contingent and dependent of survey No. 5194, which the client is aware and this is not in conformation, express or other wise, of said survey as the preliminary calculations indicate a possible difference may exist, either bearings or distance, or both, along the East line of Section.

At the South 1/4 cor. West 1/4 cor. and the North 1/4 cor. found 1 in. iron pipe and brass cap - established by the county surveyors office.

At the NE. corner of Section 5, found a 2 in. pipe, 6 ins. deep, established by the county surveyors office.

The center line of the county road was determined from found monuments at the P.I.s with a county center line spike near the North line of Sec. 5. The Westerly right of way of the county road, as shown, is from computations (note - the last few resurveys made by the Public Works Dept. of have not been recorded, as yet)

Monuments set being 5/8 in. x 24 in. iron pins, except at the termination of course S.89° 57' 31" East 308.00 feet, being a 5/8 in. x 17 in. iron pin.
