This corner was originally established by Rufus Moore in 1883 and subsequently re-established by Hans W. Thielsen in 1955 from the original record of Moore.

I find a 2 inch outside diameter iron pipe, firmly set with a brass cap attached, from which the bearing trees recorded by Thielsen were found as follows:

- A dead and down Hemlock with scribe visible, the root depression of which bears record N 440W 53.5 ft.
- A Douglas Fir 24" diam. with healed blaze bears N 83½°E 51.7 ft. (record N 83½°E 52.8 ft.)

 A Hemlock, dead and standing with unhealed blaze and
- scribe visible bears S 41°E. 33.7 ft. (record S 41°E.35 ft.)
- A Hemlock, dead and standing with scribe visible in unhealed blaze bears S 74½°W 63.7 ft. (record S 74½°W 64 ft.)
