



SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250 REVISED BY CHAPTER 555, O.L. 1963

FOR:

City of Ashland City Hall Ashland, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

To survey and monument a property line as described in Tract B, Volume 553, page 87 of the Deed Records of Jackson County, Oregon.

PROCEDURE:

Conducted a random traverse from the corner common to sections 11, 12, 13, and 14, to the Northwest corner of Donation Land Claim No. 54, and thence to the 3" iron pin accepted as being the Northeast corner of said claim 54 as established by McCall February 4, 1906, see City of Ashland field book "E", page 32.

Linear measurements by tellurometer, and angles turned with a Wild Tl-AE theodolite.

At the corner established North 0° 02° 10° East 1220.00 feet from the Northwest corner of D.L.C. 54, found a $\frac{5}{8}$ ° iron pin bearing South 0.21 feet, and East, 0.06 feet.

At the corner established South 89° 47° 07" East, 1215.40 feet from the Northwest corner of said D.L.C. 54, found a $\frac{5}{8}$ " iron pin bearing North 8.82 feet, and West, 5.85 feet.
