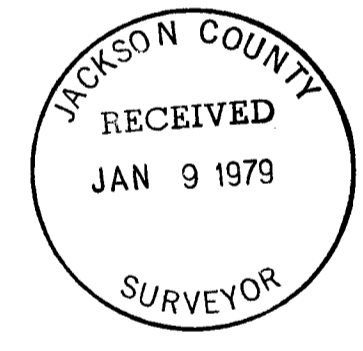

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

For: Ray Mitchell  
8000 Dead Indian Road  
Ashland, Oregon

Purpose: To monument and describe the tract as shown on the accompanying map.

Procedure: The monuments of recorded surveys no. 3306 and 7340 were held as control in establishing the Westerly and North-westerly boundaries.

The Easterly and Westerly boundaries of the tract described in Vol. 165 Page 369 D.R.J.C.O., were established according to record, extending the Southerly boundary of said tract to the existing centerline of the old Dead Indian Road.

The Northerly boundary of said tract was presumed to be the present fence along the Southerly boundary of the tract described in document no. 74-06906 of the Official Records, in absense of any evidence indicating otherwise, and was treated as such in measuring record distance there-upon.

The remaining boundaries established by this survey were located according to the clients instructions.
