SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

SURVEY FOR:

LOCATION:

Southeast one-quarter (1/4) of Section 25, Township 37 South, Range 2 West, Willamette

Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon

PURPOSE:

To survey, monument, and describe six parcels as

shown on attached map per client's request

PROCEDURE:

Recorded Survey No. 408 and 5528 were reviewed

for their contents and used as primary control for this project. Other information was compiled from City of Medford Field Books No. 205, page 111; No. 1313 (date 2-15-74); and No. 1058, pages With this control, the South line of Block 2 of "C & D" Subdivision was determined. The record distance of 220.42 feet North of said South line of Block 2 was used to determine the North line of said Block 2. The right of way lines of Plum Street and Union Avenue control the East and West boundaries of the subject A found 1 inch iron rod on the South line of Block 1 of said "C & D" Subdivision was used to control the North line of the subject tract which left a deficiency of 0.05 feet between the South line and North line of the subject tract. There were no lines of occupation that encroached onto the subject tract except in the middle of the South line where a fence made of wooden ends off of old power cable reels fell 1/2 foot North of the surveyed line.
