PURPOSE:

To establish the West one-sixteenth (1/16) corner

between Sections 9 and 16

PROCEDURE: From control established by this office during the course of performing Survey No. 7321, the West one-sixteenth (1/16) corner was set on the section line and at the distances shown on the attached map. Old tree blazes are evident along the section line, and an apparent line tree with a healed blaze on the North and South faces, indicating a North-South line, stands 5 feet East and 24 feet South of the West one-sixteenth (1/16) corner.

The following trees were double blazed and referenced to the one-sixteenth (1/16) corner:

12 inch diameter fir bears North 48° 30' West to the center of tree, 12.37 feet to nail and shiner on the Southwest face, 1 foot above ground.

14 inch diameter fir bears North 75° 30' East to the center of tree, 8.53 feet to nail and shiner on the Northwest face, 1 foot above the ground.
