

LOCATION:

West half of the Northwest one-quarter Section 28 Township 35 South Range 3 East Willamette Meridian, Jackson County Oregon

PURPOSE:

To establish porperty corners for Charles Lewis, Emil Hillig, Russell Sinclair, and George Nunes.

PROCEDURE:

Ran theodolite and EIM closed travers around exterior of section tying section and quarter section corners. Some of the BLM corners are not offical at this time, these corners were checked and found to be set within the tolerances set forth in the 1973 BIM Manual of Surveying Instructions. The South line of the Butte Falls-Fish Lake Road right of way was established from a tie to the corner common to Sections 21,22,28, and 29. Ran interior lines closing to the exterior lines and set pins as shown on attached map.

COENTRS ACCEPTED FOR CONTROL:
