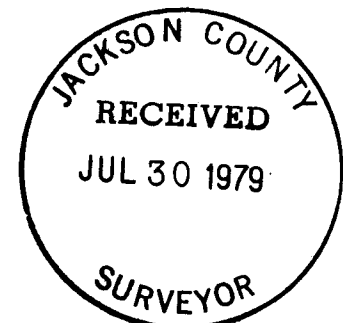

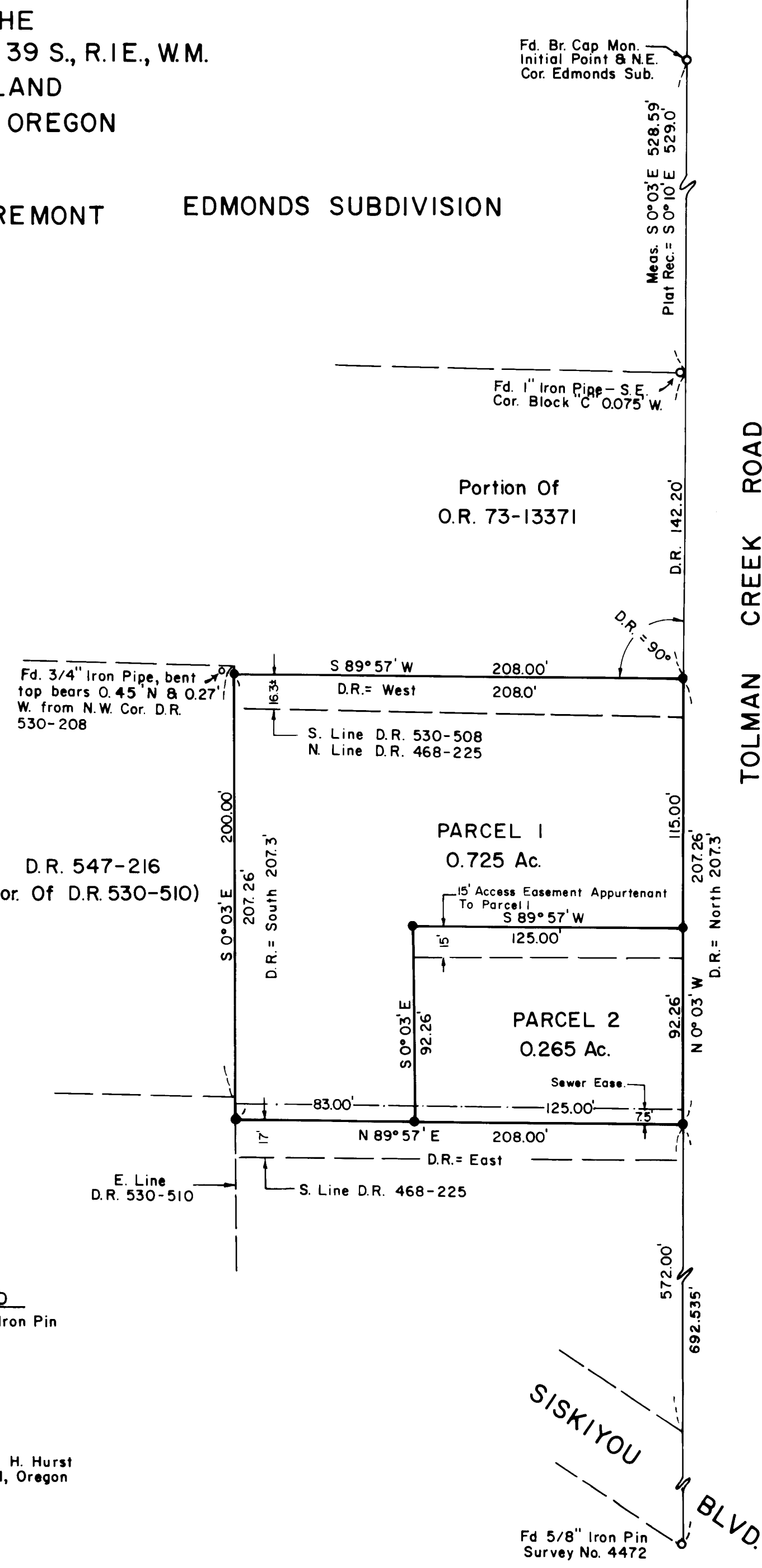

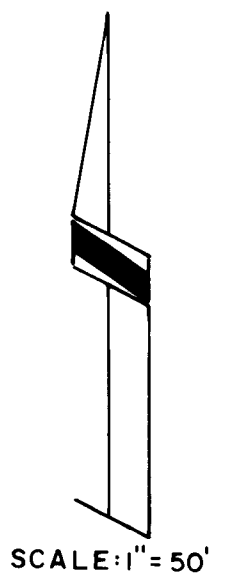
LEGEND
