Procedure:

The proposed site has been designated in the overall Airport Layout Plan, dated July 1978, for the Medford-Jackson County Airport as the local Civil Air Patrol site. Using this plan as the guide and with discussions with both airport and Civil Air Patrol personnel, the tract was staked out as shown on the accompanying map of survey based upon surveys of records shown above and monuments found in the area. This project was authorized by Edward A. McGinty, County Surveyor, at the request of the Civil Air Patrol.
