SURVEY NARRATIVE

Survey in the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 15, Township 36 South, Range 4 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

Purpose of Survey: To locate and monument the corners of the Bradley parcel.

Procedure: Bearings are referenced to Survey No. 5583.

I first traverse from a 5/8" diameter iron rod on the South line of the NW_{+}^{1} of the NW_{+}^{1} of Sec. 15, to the NW corner of Sec. 15. I locate right of way monuments along the westerly line of East Evans Creek Rd. and tie to the traverse.

I then calculate the point of intersection of the centerline of East Evans Creek Rd. with the East-West centerline of the NW_{\pm}^1 of the NW_{\pm}^1 Sec. 15, which is the point of beginning for the legal description of subject parcel. I then monument the parcel in accordance with the description. I did not set a monument along the south line, near Evans Creek, because of the encroachment by the neighbor to the South. The encroachment is shown on the plat.
