LOCATION:

Located in Section 28, Township 37 South, Range 3 East of the Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

To monument the East 1/4 corner and the center north 1/16 corner of Section 28, and the North 1/16 corner common to Sections 28 and 29. Also to mark the north, south and east lines of the North half of the Northwest quarter and the remainder of the West line of Section 28, lying South of the North 1/16.

PROCEDURE:

Using a Wild T-2 theodolite and an H.P. 3805A E.D.M. I tied all controlling corners via a series of closed traverses. After diligent search for the 1/4 corner common to Sections 28 and 27 I established the corner at the proportionate position. The proportionate position fits the call in the origial notes for the dry gulch, course East at 44.9 chains. No trace of the original stone or BT's could be found.
