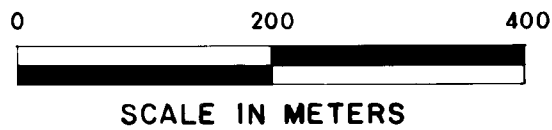

BEING A PORTION OF SECTION 22, T.40S., R.2W., W.M.

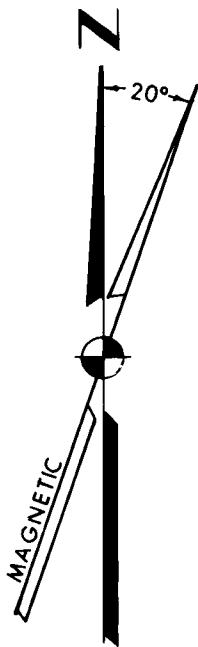

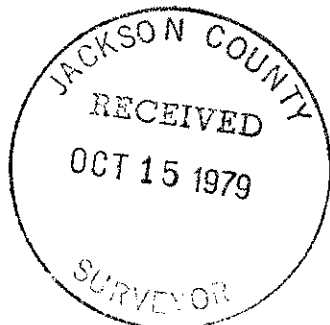

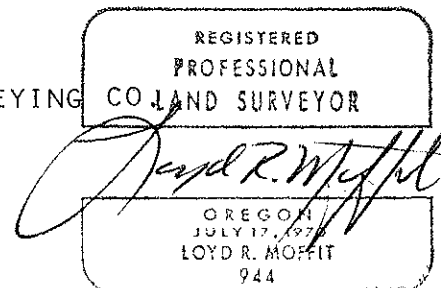

LOCATION: THE NORTH LINE AND THE WEST LINE OF SECTION
22, TOWNSHIP 40 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, WILLAMETTE
MERIDIAN, JACKSON COUNTY, OREGON.

PURPOSE: TO DETERMINE THE BOUNDARIES OF ROGUE RIVER
NATIONAL FOREST LANDS AND TO POST AND MONUMENT
SAID BOUNDARIES.

PROCEDURE: TRAVERSED BETWEEN EXISTING SECTION CORNERS
AS SHOWN ON THE ATTACHED MAP. AFTER MAKING
A DILIGENT SEARCH FOR THE WEST AND NORTH
ONE-QUARTER SECTION CORNERS, AND FINDING
NO ORIGINAL EVIDENCE, I SET SAID CORNERS
BY SINGLE PRORATION ON THE SECTION LINE.
