PURPOSE:

TO DETERMINE THE BOUNDARIES OF ROGUE RIVER NATIONAL FOREST LANDS AND TO POST AND MONUMENT

SAID BOUNDARIES.

PROCEDURE:

TRAVERSED BETWEEN EXISTING SECTION CORNERS AS SHOWN ON THE ATTACHED MAP. AFTER MAKING A DILIGENT SEARCH FOR THE WEST AND NORTH ONE-QUARTER SECTION CORNERS, AND FINDING NO ORIGINAL EVIDENCE, I SET SAID CORNERS BY SINGLE PRORATION ON THE SECTION LINE.
