Precedence of Survey:

With the utilization of previous surveys (see Sur. No.'s 1170, 5671) recovered monuments as shown.

The center line of Lewis St. was determined by recovery of a 3/4 in. iron pipe, approx. 12 ins. deep at the NW cor . of West Walnut Park Addition and a conc. mon. at the SW corner of Blk. 4.

To determine the center line - 8th St. was first analozed for improvements northerly, plat and proration with the conclusion that the most probable and best location being parallel to the northerly line of the Blk., wthis would be in harmony with the plat.

At center line of 8th & lewis, set an 8 in. spike and at the center line of 8th & Janette found a cross near the easterly edge of a city brass disc in a monument case.

The south line of Lot 10 is close agreement with occupation. The East line being in an existing ditch, the north line near NW corner agrees with the occupation with a sizeable enchroachment near the NE corner. The status quo of this enchroachment is unknow as it was not determined on this survey.

Monuments set being $5/8 \times 24$ in. iron pin, set flush with the surface.
