

"PHYSICALLY BOUNDED" PARCEL.

A parcel of land in Government Lot No.4, Section 5, Township 34 South, Range 4 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon, described as follows.

Beginning at a point located N 0° 44'52" E, 420.00ft and S 89° 55'38" E, 142.72 from the SW corner of said Government Lot No. 4, said point marked by a l inch Iron pipe and located on the North line of the described "Parcel 1" in Volume 65, page 172, Jackson County Deed Records;

thence N 02° 11'18" E, 230.96 on a line parallel to and at 25°ft. distance from the centerline of the Bureau of Land Management Access Road No. 34-5-10 to a point marked by a 1 inch Iron pipe;

thence easterly along a fence line the following courses: N 68° 52'05" E, 69.92 ft. to a 1 inch Iron pipe; S 57° 31' 13" E, 33.49 ft. to a 1 inch Iron pipe; N 74° 31'55" E, 84.64 ft. to a 1 inch Iron pipe; S 86° 42'47" E, 210.95 ft. to a 1 inch Iron pipe on the West line of the described "Parcel 2" said deed reference; thence S 0° 41'20" W, 249.01 ft. on said West line to a 1 inch Iron

thence Southwesterly on a line parallel to and at 25 ft. distance from said road centerline to the South line of said Government Lot No. 4

marked by a 1 inch Iron pipe; thence N 89° 55'38" W, 175.45 ft. to the point of beginning; containing 1.3 acres more-or-less.

- NARRATIVE OF SURVEY in Sec. 5 and 6, T. 34 S., R. 4 W., Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.
- FOR: The Robert Dollar Co., owners of Tax Lots 200 in said Sections; and Kenneth Russell, owner of Tax Lots 400, 500, and 600 of said Sec. 5.
- <u>PURPOSE</u>: To set monuments necessary to establish Robert Dollar and Kenneth Russell property corners, as shown, and to brush, blaze and flag true lines.
- EQUIPMENT: A 20-second Jena Theodolite, Hewlett Packard (HP 3800) E.D.M., 300 ft. Lufkin steel tape, and other miscellaneous tools.
- INDIVIDUALS: Witnesses include the field crew of Duane Smith, Rodney Evens, and Mallory Hicklin; the survey was conducted between September 17 and October 12, 1979.
- PROCEDURES: This survey utilized 5 miles of closed-random traverse with preliminary closures being 1/100,000 prior to balancing; ties were made to found monuments and bearing trees; after determining the positions of the ½ and 1/16 corners, the interior corners necessary to identify the Robert Dollar and Kenneth Russell land in the NW ½ of Sec. 5 were calculated and identified on the ground.
- RESULTS AND COMMENTS: The NW corner, SW corner, SE corner, and E 1/4 corner of Sec. 5 are re-established original corners found intact for this survey; the N4 corner is a single-proportion corner set in 1964; the $W_{\mathbf{x}}$ corner is an old unrecorded pipe located near the proportionate corner point and historically accepted as evidenced by the location of an old &" I. Rod near the CW 1/16th corner; the South & corner is a single-proportioned corner of Survey No. 7488 with original corner evidence lost; the Center & corner and Center West 1/16 corner, also set in Survey No. 7488 are found in proper position, however, were re-monumented in the survey. Survey No. 7488 was thoroughly checked with monument points found proper but monuments sub-standard. For more detail see corners found. A total of 13 corners were monumented in this survey; 4 witness corners were monumented along the BLM Access Rd. 25' from centerline and 4 monuments were set at fenceline angle points in Govt. Lot 4, Sec. 5 as shown on the plat. Robert Dollar Co. property lines in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ have been true-lined. The two 5.11 acre parcels in Sec. 5 and Sec. 6 have also been true-lined.
 - a. The North line and South line of the 5.11 acre parcel in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 6 are normal to the Section line.
 - b. Excess distance of the South line of Govt. Lot 4, Sec. 5 was proportioned equally to the abutting tracts since historically they were created on the same date.
 - c. The S $\frac{1}{4}$, C $\frac{1}{4}$, and CWl/16 corners of Sec. 5 were marked with small, short rebar in Survey No. 7488 and replaced with 1" I. pipe.
