Dependent Resurvey in the South Half of the Northwest Quarter and the North Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 26, Township 36 South, Range 4 West of the Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

Purpose of Survey: .To locate the boundary of Mr. Wood's property adjacent to the South and West lines of that parcel owned by the State of Oregon.

Procedure: This survey is based on Sur. No. 3599 by John Hollingsworth (L.S. 691), for the State of Oregon Highway Dept. dated 7/6/67. I begin the survey at the CW 1/16th corner where I found a 5/8" I.R., 10" below grade, from which a 54" dia. Oak tree bears N 82° E, 88.7 feet. I then measure N 2° 14' 49" E for 127.19 feet to a 5/8" I.R. on the north side of Old Stagecoach Rd. I continue N 2° 14' 49" E for 236.63 ft. to another 5/8" I.R.

I was unable to find the other monuments shown by Mr. Hollingsworth so reestablished same at the record distances at those locations shown on the accompanying plat.
