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SURVEY FOR PARTIAL SUBDIVISION OF SECTION 24, T32\$ R1E, W.M., JACKSON COUNTY, OREGON

Narrative Description to comply with Par. 209.250, O.R.S.

Boise Cascade Corp., Timber & Wood Prod. Group, P. O. Box 100, Medford, Oregon 97501

Purpose: To do such surveying as required to establish the center 1/4 corner, and marks the north 1/2 of the North-South center line.

Procedure: An electronic traverse was run, to tie in the corners shown as "found," on my map. Equipment used was a Kern 1 Second Theodolite, plus "Beetle" and "Autoranger II" E.D.M. devices. After computing out the field notes, a diligent search was made for the missing South Quarter Corner, both in the computed proportional position, and in other possible locations. One of the possibilities was in the vicinity of the record distance of 2650.56 easterly (from the southwest section corner). Considerable experience in retracing other lines run by the original, G.L.O. Surveyor, Rufus Moore, gave rise to suspicion that he could have "stubbed out" only its west 1/2 of this south section line. This belief was reinforced by my distance of over 330' greater than his record south line distance and the failure of his field notes to show any record of crossing Dode's Creek, one of the more preminent drainages in this township. All efforts to find evidence of said south quarter corner in this partially logged area ended in failure; however, and it was then set by single proportinate measures. The Center Quarter Corner was then set in its computed position, and thence the north 1/2 of the North-South center line was surveyed northerly to the North Quarter Corner. Said center line was then marked with yellow-painted blazes, yellow-flagging, and $l_2^{1}x4^{\circ}$ aluminum tags nailed below stump height.

Quarter Corner for Sections 23 & 24, found 5/8" I. Rod exp. 4", by B.L.M. unstamped "Administrative Survey" of Jan. 1979, and O.B.T.'s meas. to face: 9" Madronna S 22°E 4.8' to rotted face 10" Madronna N 47°W, 2.7' to rotten face, w/chunks of scribed wood (loose) inside, "1/4S 24!" visible.
