Found bronze cap in monument case

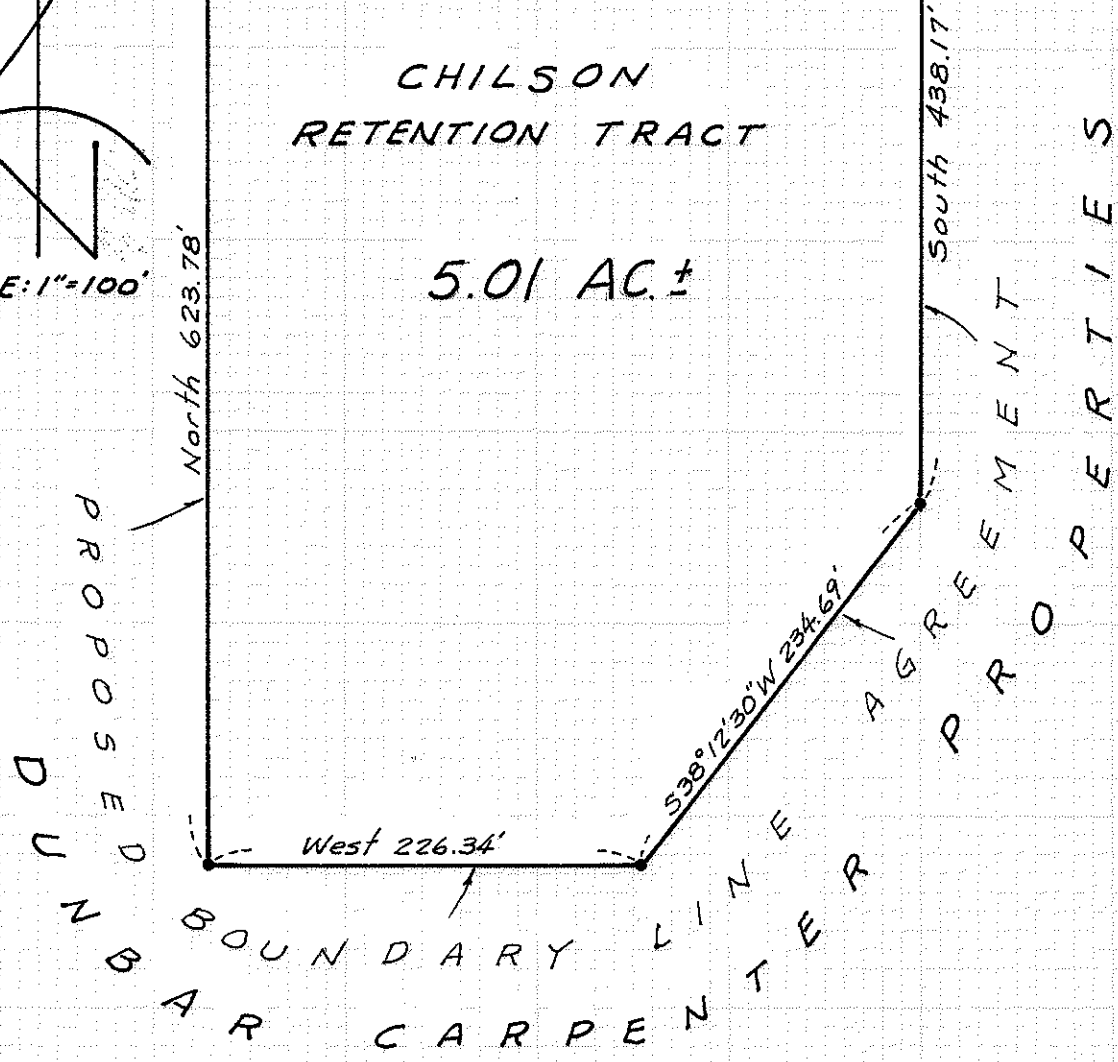
E COKER BUTTE (COUNTY) ROAD
