
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment: Charles L. Campbell, Contract No. 747, dated, May 5, 1902: Set ironstone 28"X12"X 6", 21" in the ground for 1/4, marked 1/4 on W. face from which:

A Hemlock, 20" dia., bears N48 $1/2^{\circ}$ E., 12 Links dist. marked 1/4 S31, BT.

A Hemlock, 28" dia., bears S50 1/2°W., 61 Links dist. marked 1/4 S36 BT.



Fred Mensch, Sept. 24, 1913-Destroyed mark on W. face & mark 1/4 on E. face & destroyed marks on Hemlock in Section 36.

New BT marked: A Yew, 16" dia., bears S80°E., 60 links dist., marked 1/4 S31 BT. Description of corner evidence found: Found 28"X12"X6" stone, 14" in the ground on the east side of creek with 1/4 on East side, from which:

A Hemlock, 36" dia., brs., N52°10' E., 6.60 ft. dist., (10 Links) Scribing visible.

A Yew, 20" dia., brs., S78°15' E., 40.38 ft. dist., (61.2 Links) Scribing visible.

A Hemlock, 40" dia., brs., S46°20' W., 35.46 ft., dist. (53.7 Links) Blazed-no scribing.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At the location of the original stone, I set a 2 1/2"X30" aluminum pipe 24" in the ground, in a mound of stones, with a 2 1/2 aluminum cap marked:

No new BT's marked.

T32S Wm

I buried the original stone alongside the pipe, placed USFS BT Tags on all three BTS, and painted all blazes and 6 bands on all trees with red paint. Placed boundary and attention sign 5' North of corner on a fiberglass fence post.
