

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209-250

Precedence of Survey:

In October of 1958, Survey No. 1110 was executed by L. Ager in an attempt to locate the North line of Gov't Lot 4, by running from a found 1/2 in. pipe commonly reported as the Northwest corner of Gov't Lot 4. In August of 1960 survey No. 1590 was executed by Ellis, he reran this line beginning at the same 1/2 in pipe; thence easterly on or slightly varying North a few feet at the river. A fence was built in or about 1964 on or near this line.

In 1968 a survey was executed by me, indicated previous called 1/2 in. pipe as being the NW corner of Gov't Lot 4 may be in error and I recommended a boundary line agreement (see survey No. 3744) Note, found a 5/8 in.iron pin, not shown on map which bears North 6.01 ft. from pt. No. 4.

This boundary line proposal was never consummated. Approximately 2 years ago David Boulton, as a new owner, contacted me to write a description for nortgage release on an old deeded description. I expressed my opinion to Jack Ingram and D. Boulton that the deed description and the occupation was not in harmony, that a boundary line agreement should be made. Note: recently a quit claim to Ingram on the West of line. Both parties agrred to proceed with survey as shown and boundary line description of survey.

Monements set being $5/8 \times 24$ in. iron pins.
