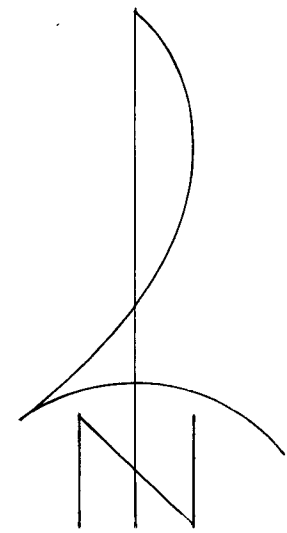


**SURVEY FOR: ARNOLD PFLUGRAD**

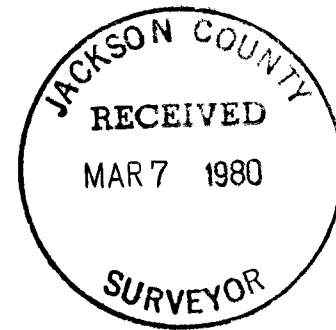

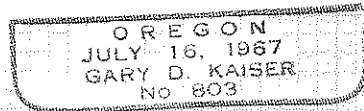
scribe a 13" Yellow Pine "C 1/4 S35-BT" which bears S 31 1/4° W,

## SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

PURPOSE: 1. To monument the tract described in Inst. No. 79-27373 O.R. and prepare a description for correcting the description utilized in said Inst. No. 79-27373 O.R.

The description used was prepared for tax lotting purposes only and does not sufficiently fix the West boundary.

2. To monument and describe Parcel I designated in the Jackson County Assessor's Office as Tax Lot No. "34 4W 35-605" and Parcel II designated as Tax Lot No. "34 4W 35-208" located in Section 35, T34SR4W, W.M.

PROCEDURE: From controls established or used on Recorded Surveys Nos. 905, 6754, 6755, 6801, 7711 and 8173 the desired tract boundaries were monumented. The Southeast corner of the tract described in Volume 527, Page 159 D.R. and the Center Quarter corner of said Section 35 were monumented as shown on the annexed map.

Basis of bearings is Recorded Survey No. 7711.

At the Center Quarter corner of Section 35 set a 3/4" x 36" galvanized iron pipe 24" in the ground with a 2" bronze cap stamped:

T34SR4W

RLS 803

from which:

scribe a 9" laurel "C 1/4 S35-BT" which bears S 27 1/4° E, 12.3 feet to the face of the lower blaze.
