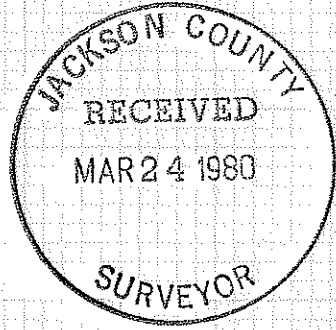


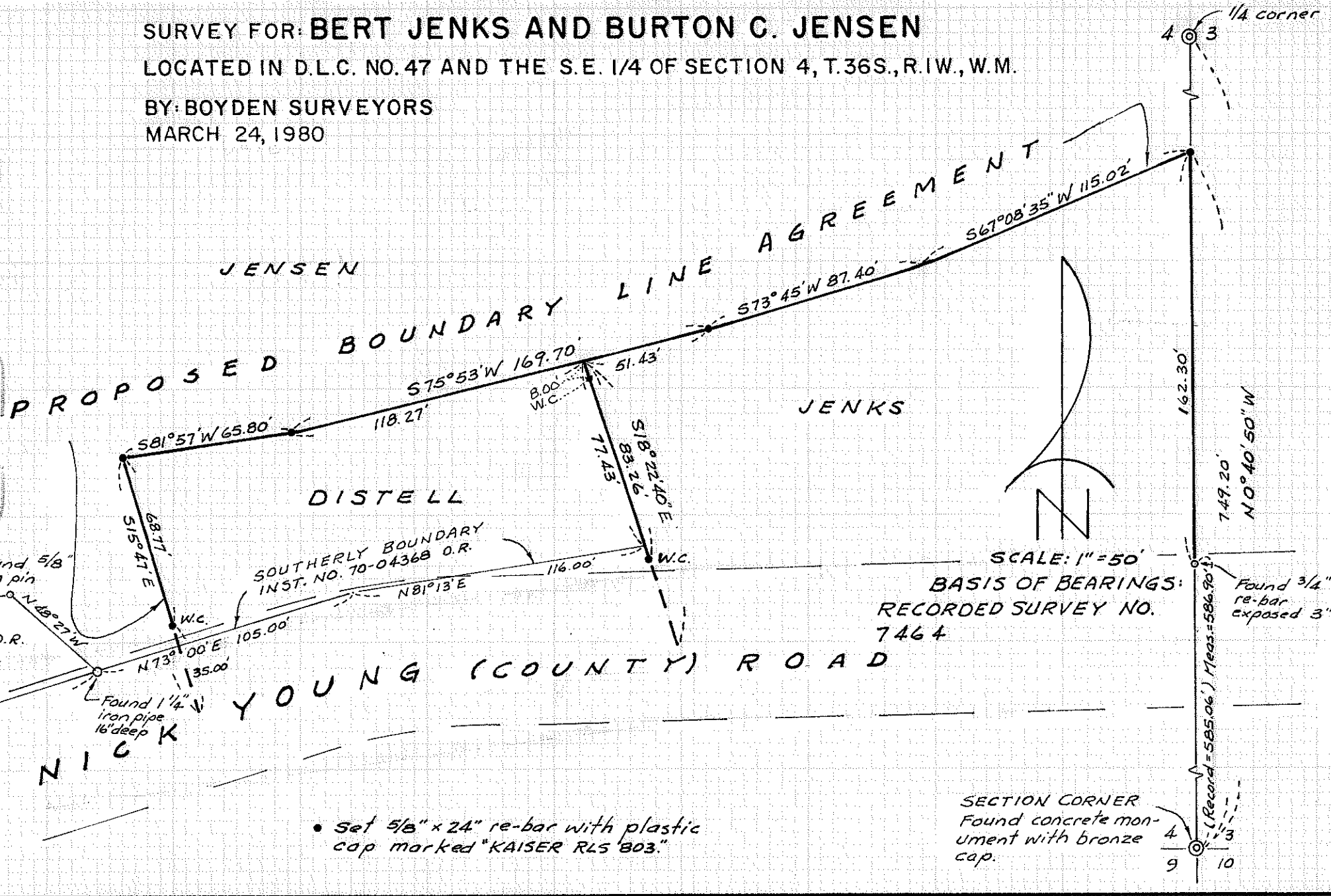

PURPOSE: To monument the boundaries of the Jenks property and to monument and describe a boundary proposed to be established by a recorded boundary line agreement between the properties of Burton C. Jensen et ux to the North and West and Bert Lee Jenks, Charles Edward Jenks, Mary E. Jenks and Eloise Distell to the South and East being located in Section 4, T36SR1W, W.M.

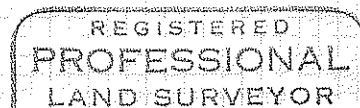
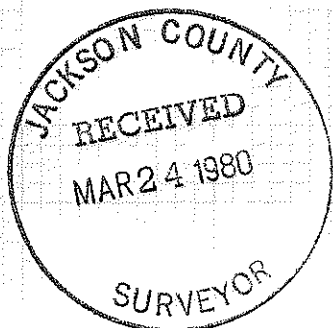
PROCEDURE: E.D.M. equipment was utilized to traverse to the control monuments shown on the annexed map.

A boundary line agreement is being used on the Northerly boundary of Jenks and Distell properties because of the impossibility of determining the location of the long since removed Medford Corp. Logging Railroad tracks which control this line.

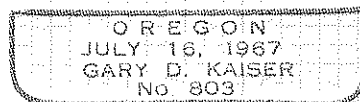
The boundary line agreement is being extended to include the Westerly boundary of the Distell property to relieve any interest Jenks may have West of the monumented line as well as position the Distell Westerly boundary.
