SURVEY NARRATIVE to comply with Paragraph 209.250, O.R.S.

PURPOSE:

To survey a parcel of land for road access in the Northeast 1/4 of Section 16, Township 36 South, Range 4 West, Willamette Meridian, Josephine County, Oregon.

PROCEDURE:

Beginning at the East 1/4 corner at which point I found a 1" iron pipe per Survey No. 915, from which

the Southwest corner of a concrete porch slab bears North $56-1/2^{\circ}$ East 97.6 feet

the corner of a concrete foundation at the South Southeast corner of a residence bears North $69-1/4^{\circ}$ West 69.2 feet.

Thence I traversed North $89^{\circ}51'03"$ West 5253.89 feet to the West 1/4 corner at which point I found a 1-1/2" iron pipe per Survey No. 1834, from which I found

- a White Oak 8" in diameter South 35-1/20 East 45 links
- a Douglas Fir 27" in diameter North 30 West 28 links

Thence I surveyed to a 2" iron pipe referred to as the accepted Center 1/4 which bears South $88^{\circ}53'52"$ West 2655.50 feet from the East 1/4 corner; thence I surveyed North $0^{\circ}19'$ West 2682.80 feet to the North 1/4 corner at which point I found a brass cap, from which I found

- a White Oak 15" in diameter North 31-1/20 West 11.5 feet
- a Black Oak 17" in diameter North 88-3/4° East 64.5 feet

Thence, using descriptions found in Deed Volume 236, Page 410 and Title Report No. 38057, I surveyed and monumented the parcel as shown on the map.

Meridian is based on the North-South center line of the Section per the deed descriptions.
