PROCEDURE: The Southerly and Easterly boundaries of the parcel described in Volume 283, Page 64, D.R. were established by proportion between the P.O.B. of said parcel (being 872.00 feet North on the West boundary of D.L.C. 42 from the Southwest corner of said Claim) and a 5/8" rebar found set for the most Easterly corner of said parcel (see Filed Survey Nos. 3087 and 4871).

The Northeasterly boundary of the tract described in Vol. 325, Page 277, D.R. was located parallel with and 404.70 feet Northeasterly at right angles from center line of the relocated Pacific Highway (U.S. 99) which agrees with monuments found set on Filed Survey No. 4871.
