SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

LOCATION:

A portion of the Southwest one-quarter (1/4) of the Northeast one-quarter (1/4) of Section 4 in Township 36 South, Range 1 East, Willamette

Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon

PURPOSE:

Monument the client's parcel according to deed

description

PROCEDURE:

The existing monumentation in and around the North-

east 1/4 of Section 4 were tied together by closed E.D.M. traverse.

The Northeast 1/4 was then subdivided by the following procedure:

The history of the Center 1/4 of Section 4 was well documented in the Narrative of Survey No. 7873 and, finding no additional evidence, the 1 inch capped pipe was accepted for the purposes of this survey. A 9 inch diameter white oak with healed single blaze bears S 45° W, 15.6 feet. No scribing found on opened blaze, and a ring

count showed approximately 16 years overgrowth.

The Center East 1/16 and the East 1/16 on the North line of Section 4 were established at points midway between quarter corners

and quarter and section corner, respectively.

The positions of the North 1/16 between Sections 3 and 4 and the Center North 1/16 of Section 4 were computed at 20 chains, proportionate measurement, Northerly from the corresponding 1/4 corners. The position of the Center North 1/16 falls a considerable distance Northerly of the monument set for the same corner on Survey No. 7873, as shown on the map. This difference is evidently due not to differences in measurement but to the methods used in determining the corner position.

The Northeast 1/16 was then established at the straight line

intersection between opposite 1/16 corners.

The client's warranty deed, recorded as Instrument No. 74-00673, describes the parcel as "...lying Northeasterly of the Brownsboro Cemetery Road ...". The roadway is not deeded or dedicated for public use and no record of its intended width could be found. It was explained to the client that the location of the property line along the roadway was vague. It was decided to monument the road-way at 12.50 feet from the traveled centerline, but that this was not intended to represent the true property line.
