Purpose:

To set the Section Corner common to Sections,26, 27,34 and 35,T.32S.,R.1E.,W.M. and to mark certain

boundaries of Boise Cascade property.

Procedure:

Random lines were run between existing controlling corners to find a position by double porporation measurement of the lost section corner to Section 26,27,34 and 35. A through search of the area surrounding the porportioned position was made, findingno original evidence. The area has been burned over twice since the original corner was set, apparently destroying all evidence. The original corner was set in 1883, and the oldest trees in the area were established about 1920(60 years ago). The topographic calls made in the original survey cannot be reconciled to existing topographic features. Based on these facts, I declared the corner lost and set the corner by double porportionate measurement. A through search was made in the area of the 1/4 corner of Section 34 and 35, finding no original evidence. Again the topographic calls could not be reconciled to record distances and the porportioned position. I did not set the 1/4 corner.

The Section lines between Section 26 and 27 and Section 34 and 35 were blazed and painted with red paint. 1 1/2 inch by 5 inch aluminum tags marked BCT PL were placed intervisable along the Section line at intervals not exceding 300 feet. The East 1/2 of the Section line between Section 27 and 34 and the West 1/2 of the Section line between Section 26 and 35 were marked in same manner. SON COUN
