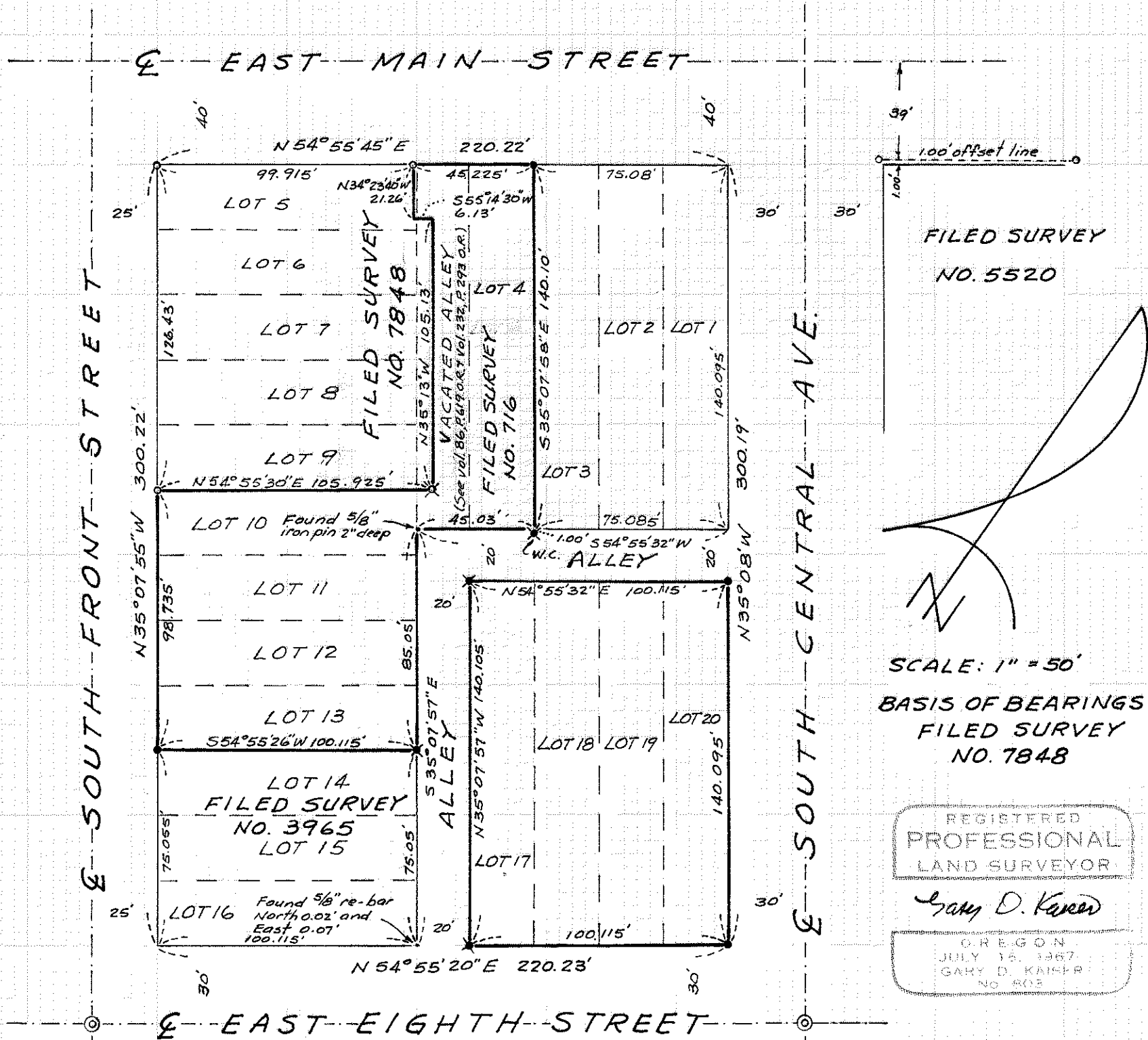

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

PURPOSE: To monument the Robinson property located in Block 20 of the ORIGINAL TOWN (now City) of Medford, Oregon not surveyed on Filed Survey No. 7848.

PROCEDURE: Using EDM equipment, traversed around said Block 20 tying monuments set on Filed Survey Nos. 5520, 716 and 7848 along with street center line monuments as shown on the annexed map.

From said control monuments, the desired tract boundaries were computed and monumented.

The only monument found of those set on Filed Survey 3965 was the 5/8" rebar set for the most Southerly corner of Lot 16. Apparently during the construction of the building on Lot 14, 15 and 16, the other monuments were destroyed and the one found was knocked out of position as indicated on the annexed map.

Basis of bearings is Filed Survey No. 7848.
