




PURPOSE:

To set a line of witness monuments near the Southerly boundary of the North-half of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 14, T37SR4W, W.M. and to prepare a description for a proposed ingress-egress and utility easement as shown on the annexed map.

PROCEDURE:

Computed a theoretical position for the above mentioned Southerly boundary from the Northwest corner, North Quarter corner, Northeast corner and East Quarter corner of said Section 14 tied on Filed Survey Nos. 5678 and 7402, and from the West Quarter corner of said Section 14, tie on this survey, being a 1" iron pipe (Record = 1 1/2" iron pipe) with a 2 1/2" br. cap set by the County Surveyor's office in 1973.

The line of witness monuments were set on a parallel offset Northerly from the computed theoretical boundary. Basis of bearings is Filed Survey No. 7402.
