

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

Township 37 South, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon


PURPOSE:

Minor Partition

A random traverse was run to locate the existing PROCEDURE: boundary monumentation of the parent tract and control along Cherry Lane. The monument for the Southeast corner of the parent tract was found to be significantly out of record position, probably due to the shifting nature of the soil in that particular area.

Discrepancies were noted between the centerline and right of way monuments along the curved portion of Cherry Lane. An analysis of the measurements and the field notes of the 1935 County Road Survey indicated that the P.I. pipe would most likely control the right of way location. The right of way and centerline monumentation was then held as shown and the parent tract divided and monumented.
