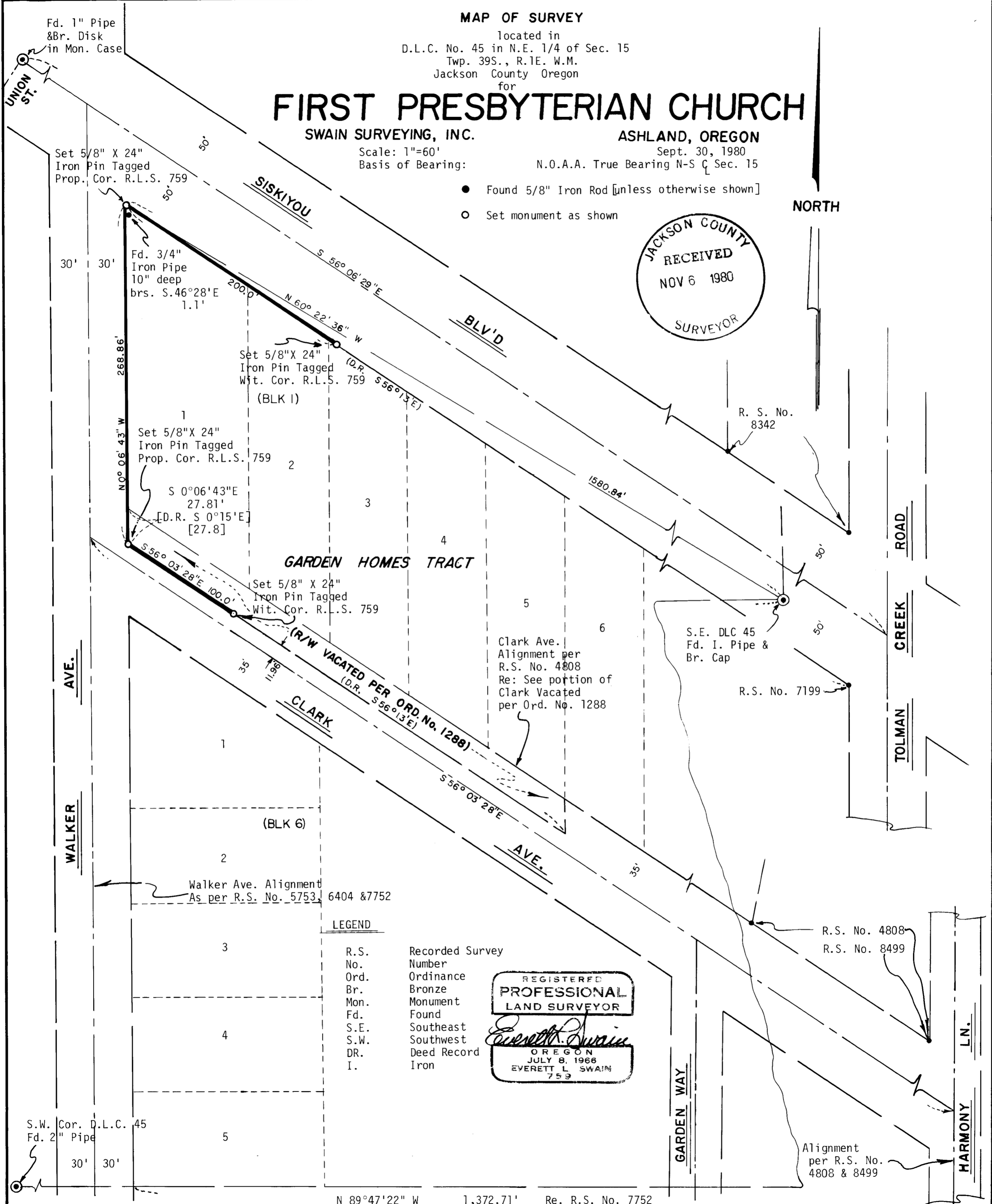

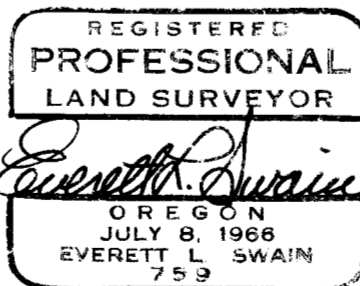

SURVEY FOR: First Presbyterian Church, Ashland

LOCATION: Situated in Donation Land Claim No. 45 and the Northeast quarter  
of Section 15 in Township 39 South, Range 1 East of the Willamette  
Base and Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE: To survey and monument a portion of the rights of way of Siskiyou  
Boulevard and Clark Avenue as well as establish the right of way  
of Walker Avenue adjacent to the church's ownership as shown hereon.
