PURPOSE:


To survey and monument several boundary lines as shown on the attached map per client's request

PROCEDURE: Using Survey Nos. 4075 and 6056 as a basis for control of this survey, tied into existing monuments as shown. It is apparent that client established his own property lines and corners for the purpose of transferring ownership. Client's request was to prepare an official survey between existing monuments showing surveyed distances and bearings for the purpose of redescribing several parcels.

The monument found at the Northwest corner of Survey No. 4075 was found out of its record position. Consultation with Surveyor Ed McGinty found that he took two references when he set the corner in question in 1969. They were a 10 inch fir at North 79° East 14.1 feet and a 6 inch pine at South 02° West 18.3 feet. After setting a new monument at the record position, I find a 13 inch fir at North 80° East 14.0 feet and an 8 inch pine stump at South 18.1 feet.
