From the corner are marked the following bearing trees:

A 12" oak bears N62° 13'W, 25.22 ft. scribed "NW1/16S27 BT" marked in C.S. 8594. A 6" fir bears N5° 45'E, 35.65 ft. scribed "NW1/16S27 BT" marked in C.S. 8594. An old rock mound bears N1°23' 32"W, 28.03 ft.

The C-N 1/16 corner of Section 27, Township 40 South, Range 4 West, Willamette Meridian. AT the corner location is set a standard U.S.F.S. brass cap set in C.S. 8594 and marked:

T40S R4W C N1/16.S27 C 1980 PLS 981

From which is marked the following bearing trees:

A 8" oak bears S75° 06'W, 8.5 ft. scribed "CN1/16 S27 BT" marked in C.S. 8594. A 10" oak bears S19° 27'E, 19.0 ft. scribed "CN1/16S27B $\overline{V}$ " marked in C.S. 8594.

Note; All bearing trees marked in C.S. 8594 are tagged with a brass washer stamped "L.S. 981" attached to the lower blaze.

The property corners and line monuments established on this survey are shown and described on the survey map. Said points are set in accordence with the property descriptions of each parcel.
