## SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

Southeast one-quarter (1/4) of Section 10, Township 36 South, Range 3 West, Willamette

Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon

PURPOSE:

To survey and monument the tract as described in Document No. 80-26149 of the Official Records of

Jackson County, Oregon

Basis of control for this survey was by monumenta-PROCEDURE: tion set per Survey No. 4441. Analysis of Survey No. 4441 and accompanying narrative and the description of Sams Valley Highway No. 234 per Volume 353, page 14, Deed Records, was found in agreement with procedures used to locate the centerline of the highway.

The Northwest and Southwest corners and the South line of the subject tract were determined from the senior deed description of the concerned tracts in this area per Volume 412, page 478, Deed The most Easterly and Northerly corners of the subject tract were determined per Volume 493, page 307. Said most Easterly corner is described as being "on the Northwesterly right of way line of Highway No. 234, said point being 1269.17 feet North and 446.81 feet East of the quarter section corner common to Sections 10 and 15 . . . " Because the Northing and Easting calls from said quarter corner do not fall on the Northwesterly right of way line, a decision was made to rotate these calls about said quarter corner until a point of intersection was reached with the right of way line. With this, used the record angle between the right of way line and the Southwesterly line of the tract described in said Volume 492, page 307, to determine the bearing of that Southwesterly line.
