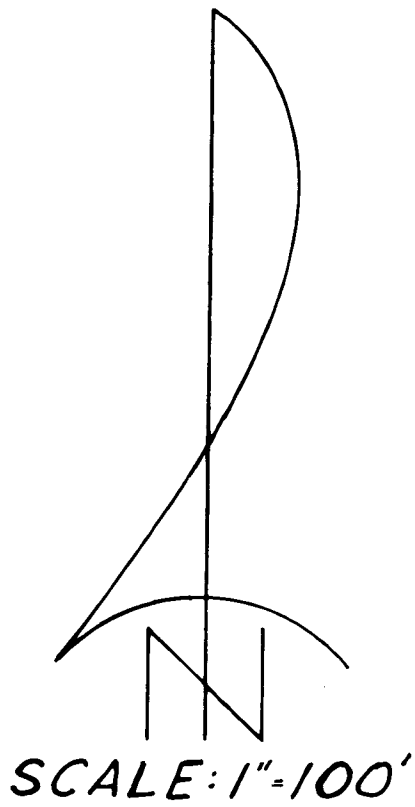


MINOR LAND PARTITION FOR DANA AND SHARLEEN PLAMONDON

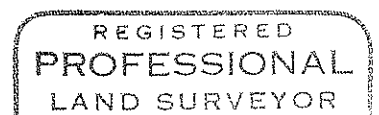
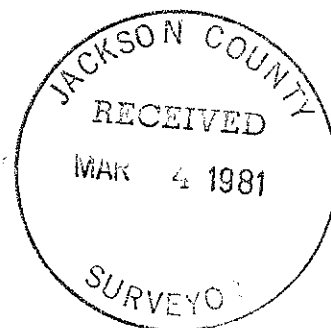
PURPOSE: To monument Parcel No. 2 and describe Parcel Nos. 1 and 3 being partition parcels of that tract described in Instrument No. 78-12777 O.R. located in the SE 1/4 of Section 6, T38SR2W, W.M.

Positions for the North, East and South boundaries of the West-half of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 6 were not determined on this survey.

PROCEDURE: Utilizing the 2" galvanized iron pipe found set for the 1/4 corner common to Sections 6 and 7 (see SHERMAN HEIGHTS, a recorded subdivision), the 1/2" iron pipe found set for the Center South 1/16 corner (see the County Surveyor's Intermediate Corner book) and the 3/4" iron pipe found set at the intersection of the Southwesterly right-of-way line of Sterling Road with the West boundary of the SE 1/4 of Section 6 (see Filed Survey No. 682) for control, the desired parcel boundaries were monumented as shown on the annexed map.

Basis of Bearings is SHERMAN HEIGHTS (a recorded subdivision).
